New Traffic Signal to be installed at 224 Street and 124 Avenue

Maple Ridge, B.C: The City of Maple Ridge is converting the intersection at 224 Street and 124 Avenue from a four way stop to a fully signalized intersection, including enhanced pedestrian amenities to match the urban standards to the south.

This intersection is being updated to reflect the current and future growth planned for the City's Town Centre Area. Part of the modifications will include changes to the contours of the intersection to create bulb outs to support better site lines for both drivers and pedestrians and reduce the crossing distance for pedestrians. These intersection changes will result in localized parking reductions in the immediate area of the intersection.

The work is projected to be complete in the fall of 2023. During construction, a four way stop procedure will be in effect and there may be traffic control personnel on site as the sidewalk contour changes and traffic lights are installed.

People are advised to follow all posted signage, use alternate routes and patience is appreciated while the City makes these upgrades.
