The culture change has been noticed by front-line employees such as Brian Patel, a Maple Ridge Youth Recreation Coordinator with 30 years of experience. Patel noted the positive shift: "We are being trusted to make decisions because we're the front-line in interacting with the community, and they're listening to us in the same way that we listen to each other. This is a wonderful place to work – the accolade is very well deserved."
