INFORMED: 232 Street Bridge Replacement

Help us Spread the Word



On Tuesday, July 16 the 232 Street bridge over the North Alouette River will be closed as part of a six month construction project to provide a new modern bridge at this site. A special web link has been created on the District website at mapleridge.ca with details of the \$4.75 million project. The work will be completed in January of 2014.

The new bridge will be constructed using steel and concrete and will be raised above the 200 year flood level to reduce impacts of extreme weather events for properties along the North Alouette River. In addition, the new bridge has been designed to meet today's earthquake standards and has a higher load capacity, thus allowing for truck traffic to head south onto 232 Street for the first time. The bridge will provide two lanes for vehicle traffic and feature separated multi-use pathways on both sides for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians. The bridge is also being designed to allow for future expansion to four lanes.

There will be a temporary pedestrian bridge available for the duration of the project, and the project has also provided bussing for students of nearby Yennadon Elementary School until the project is completed.

Traffic detour signs are in place and the District website has maps that you can send to friends and family to help them navigate around the construction zone. Thank you for your patience as we replace and upgrade this important link in our transportation network.
