### Purpose of Open House

- To present the preliminary concept design for the proposed pedestrian improvements on 236 Street and proposed Larch Avenue connection (to be done as part of development)
- To present plans for improvements on Larch Avenue by others

### Project Location

- 236 Street from Upper Maple Ridge Park (north of 130 Ave) to Larch Avenue
- Larch Avenue from 236 Street to 235 Street

### Project Objectives

- To improve safety for pedestrians
- To improve connectivity in Silver Valley

## Project Scope

- To provide 1.50m separated asphalt walkway from Upper Maple Ridge Park (north of 130 Ave) to 133 Avenue
- To provide pedestrian bridge south of 132 Avenue
- Larch Avenue road connection to be completed as part of development

## Next Steps

July 2011

Review feedback received from this Open House and prepare detailed design

Start of construction on Larch Avenue by others

Late Summer 2011

Host a second Open House to present final design drawings for the pedestrian bridge and walkway south of 132 Avenue

Start construction of the asphalt walkway from Larch to 132 Avenue

September 2011

Tender the project for pedestrian bridge and walkway south of 132 Avenue

Obtain Council Approval to award the construction of the pedestrian bridge and walkway (south of 132 Ave)

November 2011

Construct the pedestrian bridge and walkway on 236 Street (south of 132 Avenue)
