Things To Do

Status	Task
	Communicate your plan on posters, marketing materials, and with sponsors and vendors
	Draft a procedure outlining safe practices for volunteers
	Develop a schedule detailing # of volunteers required and reasonable shifts
	Communicate with food vendors about site requirements and their responsibilities – try to get them involved and helping out
	Recyclable items are worth money, determine ahead of time how to best use this resource
	Identify where on site recycling/returnable can be sorted (provide tarps if inside any facility)
	Ensure there is a suitable way for volunteers to move garbage or recyclables (dollie, truck, wagon, etc.)
	Recruit volunteers who care about the environment or are committed to the event
	Rent or buy gloves, tongs, bags, and any additional supplies you may need
	Provide orientation for volunteers, in advance if possible, or on event day prior to shift
	Determine who will supervise volunteers during event
	Include volunteers in post-event evaluation of the Waste & Recycling Plan
	Include volunteers in wrap up celebrations
	Follow up and celebrate your successes
