EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Council last endorsed an update to the Workplan Matrix prior to business planning on September 28, 2021. The current version has been updated to reflect projects added during the annual planning process. The Matrix does not represent an exhaustive list of the work undertaken by departments, but is a snapshot of key priority projects identified by Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Council Workplan Matrix dated February 22, 2022 be endorsed.

DISCUSSION:

a) Background Context:

The format of Council's Workplan Matrix, as attached, has been modified to better categorize projects that are currently in progress and those that have been completed since the beginning of Council's mandate. Both documents are in chronological order.

Notable projects which have completed since the last Matrix update include adoption of the Economic Development Strategy, Integrated Stormwater Management Plans for Kanaka Creek and South Alouette, and background studies for Thornhill. Additionally, Council adopted the 2022-2026 Financial Plan after two days of business planning.
