

INFORMED: Tax Time

Final Deadline is Tuesday, July 3. Claim Your **Home Owner Grant Online**

Your 2018 property taxes are due by midnight on Tuesday, July 3, 2018. The most important message we can highlight is that you can claim your Home Owner Grant online, which opens up many alternatives to paying in person at City Hall.

Claim your Home Owner Grant online at mapleridge.ca by clicking on Online Services. Select 'Home Owner Grant Application' and follow the instructions to claim your grant. You can also set up a 'My Maple Ridge' account which gives you 24/7 access to your tax information with an option for you to sign up for paperless tax notification as well as track your payment history. It's a great way to save time. Once you claim your Home Owner Grant you can pay the balance owing at most financial institutions either in person or by using online or telephone banking.

If you decide not to pay through your bank you have the option to drop off your Home Owner Grant and cheque at the secure drop box located at the west entrance of City Hall near the Economic Development Office as another way to avoid



any line up. The box is cleared daily and will be emptied at midnight on Tuesday, July 3, 2018. If you have any questions about your 2018 property tax notice please contact us at

INFORMED: 232 Street Road Closure

Summer Construction Road Closure Notice for Silver Valley

232 Street will be closed from the north end of the 232 Street traffic circle (south of the 232 Street bridge over the North Alouette River) to 136 Avenue from Tuesday, July 3, until Friday, August 31, 2018. There will be no access onto 132 Avenue from Fern Crescent for the closure (except for local traffic).

This will allow for the construction of a new traffic circle north of the bridge and the widening of 232 Street to urban standards including curbs, sidewalks, multi-use pathway, streetlights and storm sewers. This work will also involve the relocation of gas lines, power poles, watermains and conduit for telecommunications services.

The road will be open to residents living on this section of road, transit, police, fire and ambulance services.


