Council Meeting Schedule Set For Upcoming Year

On Tuesday, November 13, Council established their meeting calendar for the balance of 2018 through to the end of 2019. The new schedule includes a return to holding 'Committee of the Whole' meetings to provide Council with an opportunity to receive information on planning applications before they are forwarded to the regular Council meetings. The Committee of the Whole meetings will be held on the first and third Tuesday of each month starting at 1:30 pm in Council Chambers. These meetings will be live streamed on the City website and the recordings will be available for viewing at any time on the City website.

The Workshop Meetings, designed to provide Council with an opportunity for preliminary discussions on policies and other items of interest will be held each Tuesday in the Blaney Room. The meeting times will vary depending on whether or not a Committee of the Whole meeting is being held the same day. Meetings will start at either 1:30 or 3:00 pm per



the schedule. These meetings are also live streamed and recorded for public viewing.

Council Meetings and Public Hearings will remain at 7:00 pm in Council Chambers. The full schedule is available online at *mapleridge.ca/640*. Calendars are available for download in a list or calendar format. The most up-to-date calendar is also posted at each entrance of City Hall.


