Sign Up for Notifications. The Cure for Road Rage

There's an old joke that in Alberta there are two seasons, winter and construction season. Here in Maple Ridge we have a larger weather window to do work on our roads, but the reality is that the time from May to the end of October is the prime time for us to do road works and other construction relating to the maintenance of our water, sewer and storm water management systems. Sometimes the decision to complete work is made first thing in the morning based on the weather conditions, so the notice period is short.

These works can impact your commute, and while we try to mitigate the

impacts by asking our contractors and City crews to schedule work to reduce impacts during the rush hour; sometimes



emergency repairs are required. We have a system to keep everyone informed on our City website at mapleridge.ca.

You can even be more proactive and sign up for the 'Notify Me' service on the City website and you will get direct notifications to your email or smartphone of upcoming construction work. If you like the City Facebook page or follow us on Twitter you will also get these notices. The folks at the local radio stations follow us and retweet our notifications and broadcast them on air!


Thanks in advance for your patience. We've done a lot of big projects in the
