SEPTEMBER 2018 - COMPLETION

The Arthur Peake field is now open and will use a new infill product that will ensure health and safety and provide the athletes who use the facility with a superior sports surface and playing experience.

APRIL 2018 - CONSTRUCTION STARTING

Construction and contractor mobilization started at the Arthur Peake/Golden Ears field in May 2018. The Arthur Peake field will use a new infill product that will ensure health and safety and provide the athletes who use the facility with a superior sports surface and playing experience.

DECEMBER 2017 - DESIGN COMPLETE

The synthetic field design was complete.

AUGUST 2017 - DESIGN PROGRESS

A consultant team was hired with site investigations and design work to advance through Fall 2017.

JULY 2017 - DESIGN PROGRESS

Neighbours expressed concerns on the Arthur Peake / Golden Ears Elementary field concept focused on impacts due to noise, lights, traffic, parking and loss of privacy arising from the field use, as well as the loss of the existing grass field. These impacts will be addressed through the design phase as well as further consultations with the neighbourhood.

JULY 2017 - OPEN HOUSE

Maple Ridge Parks, Recreation & Culture hosted an open house to gather public input into the synthetic field concept plans for both the Arthur Peake/Golden Ears Elementary project as well as the Telosky/Thomas Haney Secondary Project.

SUMMER 2017 - COMMENT FORM

JUNE 2017 - CONCEPT

Conceptual planning started for a new synthetic turf field at the shared site of Golden Ears Elementary and Arthur Peake Centre. Plans included expanded parking off of 116 Avnue and a full size, lit synthetic turf field.
