Why the Information Session?

The City would like to provide information to the property owners, commuters and residents regarding the 232 Street and 116 Avenue corridor improvements.

What are the City's Objectives?

- Provide for safe, convenient and accessible movement of people, goods and services along 232 Street
- Provide strong multi-modal connections
- Upgrade the aesthetic of the 232 Street corridor to improve the user experience
- Create more opportunities for residents to choose transit, cycling and walking as modes of transport

What is the Scope?

- Finish roadway with two travel lanes including streetlights, sidewalks and curbs on both sides
- Provide multi-use pathway on west side of roadway. This will provide a safe connection between existing facility to the south and future facilities to the north of Dewdney Trunk Road
- Provide a multi-use path connection on 116 Ave to link to the newly constructed Trans Canada Trail section from Telosky Stadium to Thomas Haney Secondary School
- Enhance safety at intersections and provide safe access to bus stops and adequate space for waiting areas
