## FILMING NOTIFICATION LETTER

Dear Neighbours of ACT Centre & Memorial Peace Park

Please take a moment to read this notice about filming the TV series “Van Helsing” at the ACT Centre, 11944 Haney Place and Memorial Peace Park on **Tuesday, September 8, 2020**. Helsing S5 Productions Inc. would like to provide some information that will help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our activity may impact your daily routine.

Again, with Covid 19 remaining a concern for all of us, we’d like to stress that our production practices strict health and safety guidelines everywhere we work. These guidelines are in compliance with WorkSafeBC’s Health and Safety protocols developed for the Motion Picture Industry.

The following is an outline of our upcoming filming dates, times, locations, and significant action:

### **Tuesday, September 8th**

7:00am – 9:00am:	Work trucks and crew begin to arrive and park on site.
9:00am – 4:30pm:	Filming interior scenes in the ACT Centre.
4:30pm – 9:00pm:	Filming exterior scenes in Memorial Peace Park.
9:00pm – 10:00pm	Crew will secure gear and quietly leave the area.

Our work inside the ACT Centre will consist of basic dialogue scenes. In the park we have several dialogue scenes in and around the bandstand and at the Southeast corner of the park. We also have one scene of a van driving along Haney Place. Ridge Meadows RCMP will be with us to conduct short traffic stoppages along Haney Place as we film these exterior scenes. Our work will also include the use of a generator and various lighting positions. Particularly to facilitate our limited night filming.

To minimize disruption to your neighbourhood, crew cars and non essential film vehicles will be parked off site in a private parking lot. However, to accommodate our support trucks and for continuity, The City of Maple Ridge will permit our production to park as follows;

### **Tuesday, September 8th @ 7:00am until 10:00pm.**

South side of Dewdney Trunk Road from 224th to Edge Street.
