


The Hammond Community Centre is a well-used and well-loved part of the Hammond Neighbourhood.

The Centre shares a site with the outdoor pool, basketball court, and the adjacent baseball and soccer fields. All are in high demand and bring many users to the site. The Community Hall has the capacity to hold 140 people and can be adapted for a wide variety of uses. Discussions with users and caretakers, as well as a review of the Hall itself, suggest that a variety of upgrades to this facility could increase functionality and extend the life of the Hall. The suggested upgrades are intended to make Hammond Hall more attractive to existing and potential users, deal with aging infrastructure, and allow the Hall to continue to serve the community as a gathering place.

Project Vision & Objectives

- Rejuvenate the existing community centre through upgrades that attract existing and potential users and address the aging infrastructure allowing the Hall to continue to serve the community as a gathering space.
- Sustain existing programs and accommodate future ones
- Update existing landscape and add new outdoor terraces
- Provide a new fieldhouse with washrooms to cater to the field and court uses
















In 2016, the City of Maple Ridge with HCMA Architecture & Design, conducted public and stakeholder consultation to establish the project framework. These drawings summarize the proposed changes. In 2018, the City committed funding to various projects through the Alternative Approval Process, which included funding for upgrades to the Hammond site.

Community Centre (purple/blue)


- Building envelope upgrades





The intent of the new Main Hall doors is to create a sense of openness and connection with the outdoor terraces and landscape.


Ideas for **Re-Cladding the Community Centre**

Examples of Fieldhouse Washrooms









The new fieldhouse aims to be a durable, attractive and inclusive facility for all of the outdoor play activities.

Inspiration for some of the features that will be updated





The new fieldhouse will replace the existing aging washroom and changeroom building. It will retain the number of fixtures but in a different configuration that will provide three to four universally accessible washrooms to accommodate a diverse range of users. The fieldhouse is inspired by the unique architecture of the existing Community Centre and will be finished in a complementary manner.

Siting Option 1 ----


Locate Fieldhouse next to playing fields & sports court

Siting Option 2 ----


Locate Fieldhouse next to sports court


Provides shorter distance to existing services near entry point to site




FIELDHOUSE LOCATION OPTIONS










FIELDHOUSE CONCEPTUAL RENDERING
