

Bylaw No. 7841-2022 - Statutory Right of Way Over Dedicated Park and Dedicated Road for Metro Vancouver's Forcemain Project

ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS ELECTOR RESPONSE FORM

I am OPPOSED to the District of Maple Ridge proceeding with the adoption of Bylaw No. 7841-2022 - Statutory Right of Way Over Dedicated Park and Dedicated Road for Metro Vancouver's Forcemain Project, which provides necessary routing of a Metro Vancouver sanitary forcemain in Dedicated Park Land and to do all things necessary in connection with this construction including, but not limited to, the acquisition of all such real property, easements, rights-of-way or authorities as may be requisite or desirable.

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that:

- I am eighteen years of age or older; and
- I am a Canadian citizen; and
- I have resided in British Columbia for at least the last six months; and
- I have resided in the City of Maple Ridge for at least the last thirty days OR I am, or have been a registered owner of real property in the City of Maple Ridge and I have (if there is more than one registered owner) the written consent of a majority of the registered owners of that property to be the only person entitled to sign an elector response form as a non-resident property elector in relation to that property; and
- I am not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment or otherwise disqualified by law from voting in location elections; and
- I am entitled to sign this alternative approval process elector response form and have not previously signed an alternative approval process elector response form for the proposed bylaw.

All alternative approval process elector response forms must be received by the Corporate Officer, 11995 Haney Place, Maple Ridge, BC V2X 6A9 on or before 4:00 p.m. on September 6, 2022. Regular office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, statutory holidays excluded. Elector response forms may not be submitted by email or facsimile.

NOTE: A person must not sign any alternative approval process elector response form more than once and may not withdraw his or her name from the alternative approval process elector response form after the deadline for submission of the petitions has passed. Accurate copies of this elector response form may be made and used for signing. You must meet the requirements above in order to sign this form.

The number of electors of the City of Maple Ridge is estimated to be 65,231. If 10% (6,523) of the estimated number of electors of the City of Maple Ridge sign an alternative approval process elector response form opposing the bylaw, Council will not be able to proceed without then receiving the assent of the electors.
