

### **2003 MTP – Road Network Improvements**








### 2003 MTP - Bicycle Network Expansion








### 2003 MTP - Pedestrian Facility Expansion

### 2003 MTP – What's Been Implemented

- Maple Ridge has made significant progress implementing the previous plan
- Over 120 projects were identified
- Over 40% of identified projects have been completed or partially completed

	% Fully Completed	% Partially Complete	% Fully or Partially Complete
Road Network	10%	11%	21%
Transit	10%	0%	10%
Bicycle	15%	29%	44%
Pedestrians	7%	50%	57%

### **Key Aspirations & Issues**

#### Corporate Strategic Plan

**Key Transportation Strategies:** 

- Maintain and enhance a multi-modal transportation system within Maple Ridge to provide citizens with safe, efficient alternatives for the movement of individuals and goods
- Promote alternative modes (pedestrian, bike, public transit) of travel to reduce reliance on the automobile
- Continue to improve the walkability of the downtown, ensuring it is pedestrian friendly and accessible, particularly for those with impaired mobility
- 4. In co-operation with other regional stakeholders, identify improvements to the inter-municipal transportation system within the Lower Mainland and the Fraser Valley



## **Key Aspirations & Issues Road Network**

- East-west mobility
- Short-cutting (community streets)
- Regional connection
- Road network discontinuities
- Railway crossings
- Development areas
- Railway crossings







## **Key Aspirations & Issues Transit**

- Performance low ridership on most local routes
- Service Quality &
   Flexibility 'one size fits all' does not work for Maple Ridge
- **Support Strategies** i.e. passenger facilities, queue jumpers, transit exchanges, etc.
- Rapid transit
   integration -- integration
   with Evergreen Line

#### West Coast Express

- Need for park-and-ride at Port Haney
- Limited peak service
- Weekend service
- Lack of station at east end of District





## **Key Aspirations & Issues Cycling**

- Incomplete bicycle network
- Need for on-street facilities
- Connections between onand off-street facilities
- Connections to new developmetns (ie Silver Valley)
- Support measures (e.g., bicycle parking)
- Consistency and coordination of design and treatments







# Key Aspirations & Issues Walkability

- Sidewalk connectivity & accessibility
- Connections to new developments (ie Silver Valley)
- Sidewalk standards (concrete vs asphalt/gravel)
- Rural roads / shoulders
- Safety at crossings
- Trail connections
- Pedestrian barriers (e.g., railway, Lougheed, etc)





# **Challenges**Walkability

- Land acquisition for right-of-way
- Timing (impending development)
- Other infrastructure requirements (e.g. storm drainage, relocation of hydro poles)
- Minimizing redundancies (installing temporary facilities)





### **Transportation Plan Next Steps**

- Identify gaps and opportunities
- Develop modal plans
- Identify priorities
- Develop phasing strategy (short-term, medium-term, long-term)
- Develop financing plan
- Leverage other agency funds (TrasnLink, Province, Federal)





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
