JANUARY 2021 – NEW PLAYGROUNDS COMPLETE

Thank you for all your comments on what you would like to see in these new playgrounds. Based on your feedback, we've determined the new play features for this project. The construction took place late March or early April. During this time, the playgrounds and immediate areas were closed for 2 – 3 weeks and have now been re-opened as the new playgrounds have been completed.

OCTOBER 2020 – PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Maple Ridge Parks, Recreation & Culture department proposed replacing the play equipment at Country Lane North Park (corner of 102A Ave and 243 St), the play structure at Creek's Crossing Park (corner of Hill Ave and 240A St) as well as replace the spring toys at Country Lane South Park (corner of 101 Ave and 244 St).

These playgrounds were originally installed by the developers of these residential areas and have now been identified for replacement due to their age and condition. The small spray pads at both Country Lane Parks were refurbished and piece of play equipment was replaced at Country Lane South earlier this year.

These neighbourhood playgrounds were designed for the 2-5 year old age range of children. We heard from area residents about what kind or types of play equipment they would like to see these playgrounds replaced with.

Due to COVID-19 we encouraged residents to submit comments online. We invited your feedback on this project from October 2 to October 21, 2020.
