



Apply to be an Assent Voting Scrutineer

On Saturday, October 17, 2026, the City of Maple Ridge will host assent voting (also known as a referendum) on three proposed questions authorizing borrowing to fund the following three Recreation Ready projects. Voter assent is required for long-term borrowing for major projects.

Eligible voters will be asked to vote Yes or No on the following questions:



Hammond Aquatics and Recreation Centre Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 8123-2026

Are you in favour of the City of Maple Ridge adopting the Hammond Aquatics and Recreation Centre Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 8123-2026 to authorize borrowing up to \$227,000,000 for a term up to 25 years to construct an aquatic recreation centre at the properties located at 11509 207 Street, 20601 Westfield Avenue and an unaddressed property (PID: [013-715-984])?



Hammond Multi-Use Community Park Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 8124-2026

Are you in favour of the City of Maple Ridge adopting the Hammond Multi-Use Community Park Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 8124-2026 to authorize borrowing up to \$23,000,000 for a term up to 25 years to construct a multi-use community park at the property located at 20818 Golf Lane?



Albion Twin-Rink Arenas Expansion Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 8122-2026

Are you in favour of the City of Maple Ridge adopting the Albion Twin-Rink Arenas Expansion Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 8122-2026 to authorize borrowing up to \$143,000,000 for a term up to 25 years to construct a twin-rink arena expansion at the property located at 23588 Jim Robson Way?

Apply to be a Scrutineer

The City is accepting applications from eligible people who wish to serve as scrutineers for the assent voting questions. Scrutineers may be appointed to observe the voting process who are either in favour of a question or opposed to a question.

To be eligible, a person must be entitled to vote as an elector in this assent voting opportunity.

If enough applications are received, the Chief Election Officer will appoint:

- one (1) scrutineer in favour of each question for each voting place;
- one (1) scrutineer opposed to each question for each voting place; and
- one scrutineer in favour of each question and one scrutineer opposed to each question to attend the determination of the official results and, if required, any judicial recount.

Completed applications can be submitted online on the City's website or to the Election Office at Maple Ridge City Hall during regular business hours (8 am – 4 pm, Monday-Friday), from September 19 to September 28, 2026.
