3. Permit is not transferable

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4. Permit holder is responsible for the de-chlorination of all water discharged to creeks, rivers, and the storm sewer system
5. Permit holder is responsible for obtaining permits from the Ministry of Environment and Parks when discharging water to sensitive areas
6. Permit holder is responsible for any and all repair costs if the fire hydrant is damaged during the operation of this permit. City staff will test the hydrant following use by the applicant
7. The City is not responsible for any damage to private or public property during the use of this permit
