Key Result: Adopt a Climate Action Plan



This key result focused on creating a plan to address the most important climate related risks for our community. It builds a low-carbon resilience approach to tackle problems associated with climate change for, and with, the community.

What changed

By creating a comprehensive plan, grounded in community input, the City now has over 58 specific and measurable actions it is taking over the next 2, 5, and 10 years that will mitigate risks and build resilience for, and with, our community. The plan was adopted by Council in June 2025 and is now being implemented by cross-departmental teams in partnership with other levels of government and community organizations committed to climate action.

Why it matters

As we have hotter summers, more intense storm events, and increased risk of wildfires, the plan helps the City to empower residents to act individually and together. Through information sharing, advocacy, tools and resources enabled by the plan, residents will build resilience to withstand climate impacts. Examples include making homes better able to stay cool during heatwaves through Zero Carbon Step Code requirements for new homes and supporting residents to build their own air filters to keep out wildfire smoke.

Resident input was at the heart of the Resilient Future 2050 climate action plan. Our community is passionate about preserving our natural environment and ensuring that residents can maintain a high quality of life as the climate continues to change.
