



City of Maple Ridge Game On 2026 Passport Program – Terms & Conditions

1. Sponsor

This contest is administered by the City of Maple Ridge (“the City”), located at 11995 Haney Place, Maple Ridge in conjunction with the Downtown Maple Ridge Business Improvement Association (“DMRBIA”) located at 22374 Lougheed Hwy, Maple Ridge.

2. Eligibility

The contest is open to legal residents of Canada who are at least 19 years of age at the time of entry. Employees, elected officials, and contractors of the City, as well as their immediate family members and those living in the same household, are not eligible to participate.

3. Contest Period

The contest begins on 05 June at 12:00 a.m. and ends on 31 July at 11:59 p.m. (the “Contest Period”).

4. How to Participate

Residents and visitors are invited to explore Maple Ridge by visiting participating locations and scanning official contest QR codes. QR codes will be displayed at designated businesses, attractions and selected locations throughout the community. Each valid scan will earn participants points. Points collected during the Contest Period will automatically be converted into entries into the prize draw (100 point = 1 entry, unless otherwise stated). Participants must use their own mobile device to scan QR codes.

No Purchase Necessary:

Purchase is not required to enter the prize draw. To enter, simply scan the QR codes and follow instructions on the webpage.

Limits:

Participants may earn 20 soccer points per QR code scan per unique location per day. 100 points equal one entry into the draw. There is no limit to the number of different locations you may visit in a day. The City reserves the right to limit or disqualify excessive or suspicious activity.

5. Prizes

Prizes available to be won include:

Local experience packages, gift cards, event tickets and much more. Approximate retail value for the prizes are: \$300 for the weekly draws, \$500 for the Prize trail weekend and \$1000 for the Grand Prize. Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be exchanged, transferred, or redeemed for cash. The City reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if required.

6. Winner Selection

2 random draws will take place every week from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. Selected participants will be contacted via [email/phone provided upon registration within 2 days.

To be declared a winner, selected participants must:

- Correctly answer a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question

- Confirm eligibility and compliance with these Terms & Conditions
- Sign and return a declaration and release form, if required

If a selected participant cannot be contacted within [5] days, another entry may be selected.

7. Odds of Winning

Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received.

8. Fair Play & Use of Technology

Participants agree not to:

Use automated tools, bots, or scripts to scan QR codes

Attempt to manipulate location data or duplicate scans

Interfere with the normal operation of the contest

The City reserves the right to disqualify any participant suspected of misuse or abuse of the system.

9. Publicity

By accepting a prize, winners agree to the use of their name, general location (e.g., city), and/or photograph for promotional purposes related to this contest, without additional compensation, unless prohibited by law.

10. Privacy

Personal information collected will be used solely for contest administration and communication with participants.

The City collects, uses, and protects personal information in accordance with the **Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA)**. 11. Limitation of Liability

The City is not responsible for:

Technical issues, including mobile device compatibility, connectivity, or QR code scanning failures

Lost, late, incomplete, or misdirected entries. Any injury, loss, or damage arising from participation in the contest or acceptance of a prize.

12. Modification or Cancellation

The City reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify the contest at any time if technical issues, fraud, or other factors beyond its control affect the integrity of the contest.

13. Governing Law

This contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations and is governed by the laws of the Province of British Columbia and Canada.
